Business and Performance People and Culture Presentation

Mr Jordan Kelly, ED B&P provided the Committee with an overview of the work being undertaken to improve culture and engagement. The Committee noted the extensive work in progress across the service and the ongoing commitment to improving culture led by Jordan and the team.

Primary Care Partnerships

Ms Vicky Gee provided the Committee with an update on the NMHS and WAPHA shared vision and alignment to Sustainable Health Review Recommendation No. 10. The current partnership priority protocol areas of Chronic Condition Management for COPD patients; Concussion Management Pathway; Mental Health and Aged Care were discussed noting a vast array of actions are underway. The vital role played by GP liaison positions and Liaison GPs was identified. There is a need to consider NMHS priority areas in bridging tertiary care with Community and Primary care.

Workforce Dashboards

Bi-monthly the Committee receive dashboards from Business & Performance covering OSH, Contract Permanency Provision (CPP), Industrial Matters update and Integrity Dashboard. The Committee noted their appreciation of this information and the ongoing involvement of the reporting to ensure the Committee, and Board, are apprised of relevant information.

Aboriginal Health Champions

Information was provided and discussed with the Committee commenting on the excellent work being undertaken in this space noting that Aboriginal employees will hopefully be encouraged to take up roles in this area. The information will also be provided to the Board for consideration of direct nominations.

Minister for Health Your Voice in Health Survey Report

The quarterly report was provided to the Committee for information noting progress across a number of key actions. The Committee noted that with the deferral of the survey for 2022 it has allowed for greater focus on actions with pleasing results which will be fed back to the DoH and Minister for Health.

PEC Ambassador Model

The Committee continues to receive updates regarding the implementation of this model and noted that it is expected to be finalised in July 2022 with nominations of members to be sought to improve the impact of the Ambassador network.
