



Social Inclusion Mirrabooka and Surrounds

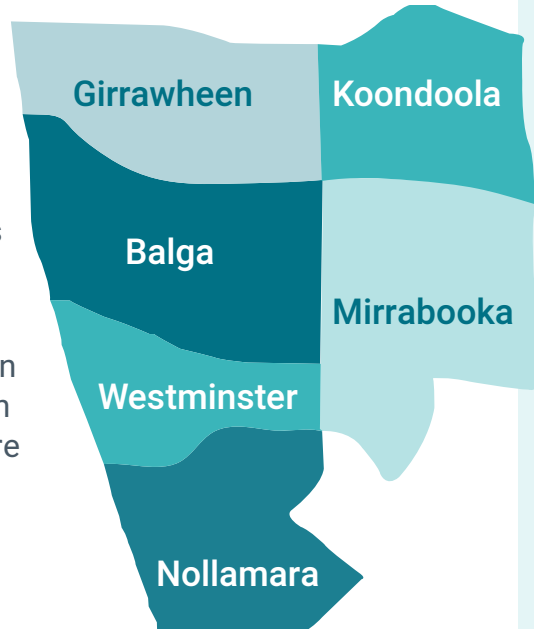


Membership group
